- Joe has already booked Smooshed (ice cream sandwiches) and Jeanne has a coffee vendor
- Food vendors so far Vito's, Smooshed, coffee truck, Schult's @ concessions
- Sponsorships DeAnna will review last year's form and update as necessary
- Is there anything else we can offer? Other sponsorship levels?
- Could have signs on stadium fence but would have to remove after competition
- Once we know what we are offering can start contacting sponsors
- Would have to email form to parents over the summer
- Jennifer Schult could ask captains to give to kids
